A 90-day AI adoption programme, run with you

Most AI programmes stall between the pilot and the proof. The technology rarely fails. What fails is ownership — nobody runs the rollout, and nobody can tie it to a business outcome. Fronterio Live is a fixed-scope engagement. In one quarter it takes an organisation from scattered AI tools to a governed, measured adoption programme its board can read.

A consultancy would produce these deliverables in slides and take them away when it leaves. Here every deliverable is generated inside a platform you own, from your own data. The assessment re-runs, the register stays current, and the board pack regenerates next quarter without anyone being re-hired.

The 90 days

DESIGN

Weeks 1–2

1. See where you actually are

A readiness assessment across five dimensions, answered by more than one person — so the gap between what leadership believes and what the team experiences becomes visible. Benchmarked against anonymised peers.

DESIGN

Weeks 3–4

2. Decide what you are actually doing

A facilitated leadership workshop turns the assessment into a strategy your leadership team ratifies — run-of-show, framework and editable slide deck included. It settles where AI fits, which initiatives come first, who owns them, and what each has to move.

ADOPT

Weeks 5–8

3. Get people actually using it

The half that gets skipped. A champions network in the departments that matter, a communications kit written for your context, and a measured pulse on how the change is really landing.

Champions network, stood up · Communications kit for the rollout · Culture pulse and barrier tracking

GOVERN

Weeks 7–10

4. Put a floor under it

Every AI system in use gets an owner, a risk tier and an accountable record — including the ones nobody registered. Compliance becomes a file you can hand over.

Agent and AI system register · Risk tiering and ownership · Compliance evidence file

PROVE

Weeks 11–12

5. Show what it was worth

The programme ends with an artifact, not a meeting. The board gets a report covering adoption, spend and outcomes — plus the cadence to produce the next one without us.

Monthly adoption report · Executive board pack · The cadence to repeat it

What you keep

The platform

Twelve months of Fronterio included. Every artifact produced during the programme lives in it and keeps updating after we leave.

The cadence

Board pack, adoption report and evidence file are scheduled and nudged, so the reporting rhythm survives without anyone remembering it.

The people

Champions, named owners and a trained leadership team — capability transferred, not a dependency created.

A fit if

- + A European mid-market organisation, roughly 100 to 2,000 people.
- + Already paying for AI tools — Copilot, ChatGPT, Gemini, Claude — without being able to prove what they returned.
- + Someone at board or executive level has asked what the AI plan is.
- + Wants the capability in-house afterwards, not a consultant on retainer.

Not a fit if you

- Wants an agency to build and run their AI. The platform helps your team build and deploy agents — to Copilot Studio, Azure AI Foundry and others — and Fronterio governs what runs. We do not operate your AI for you. The capability stays in your organisation instead of being billed back every quarter.
- Cannot get leadership in the room. The strategy is ratified by your leadership team and the board pack goes to a real board. Delegated entirely to IT, this programme fails — better to say so now than in week nine.

Start free. The AI Readiness Assessment at fronterio.com scores five dimensions, benchmarks against peers and produces a board-grade report in about 10 minutes. Run stage one yourself, then decide whether you want the other 88 days run with you.

Delivery capacity is deliberately limited — only a small number of programmes run at a time. Fixed scope, fixed timeline, platform included.
